1. Terms defined in the scheme document of the Company dated 28 May 2026 (the “**Scheme Document**”) shall apply equally in this form unless the context otherwise requires. Full details of the resolution are set out, together with explanatory notes, in the Notice of Court Meeting contained in Part 10 of the Scheme Document. Before completing this form, please also read paragraph 10 and paragraph 18 of Part 2 (Explanatory Statement) of the Scheme Document.
2. Any changes to the arrangements for the Court Meeting will be communicated to shareholders before the meeting through the Company’s website <https://delticenergy.com/disclaimer/> and, where appropriate, through a Regulatory Information Service.
3. If you wish to vote at the Court Meeting but are unable to attend in person, you may appoint a proxy to exercise all or any of your rights to attend, speak and vote on your behalf by completing the form of proxy. A proxy need not be a member of the Company. If you wish to appoint a proxy other than the Chair, you should delete the words ‘the Chair of the meeting or’ and enter the name of the proxy where indicated on the form of proxy. Your changes should be initialled. If you sign and return the form of proxy with no name of your proxy inserted where indicated, the Chair of the meeting will be deemed to be your proxy.
4. You may appoint more than one proxy provided that each proxy is appointed in respect of the rights attached to a different share or shares held by you. You may not appoint more than one proxy to exercise rights attached to the same share(s). To appoint more than one proxy you may photocopy this form of proxy. Please mark the box on the form of proxy above with an “X” to indicate that the proxy appointment is one of multiple instructions being given and insert in the box where indicated the number of shares in relation to which they are entitled to act as your proxy (which, in aggregate, should not exceed the total number of shares held by you). 5. Appointment of a proxy (or submission of a CREST Proxy Instruction, as described in the Notice of the Court Meeting contained in Part 10 of the Scheme Document) does not preclude a member from attending the meeting and voting in person.
6. Any alteration to this Form of Proxy must be initialled.
7. Pursuant to Regulation 41 of the Uncertificated Securities Regulations 2001, those shareholders registered in the Register of Members of the Company at 6.00 p.m. on 22 June 2026 or, in the event that the meeting is adjourned, in the Register of Members at 6.00 p.m. on the day which is two business days (ignoring any part of a day that is not a working day) before the start of any adjourned meeting, shall be entitled to attend and vote at the meeting in respect of the number of shares registered in their name at the relevant time. Changes to entries on the Register of Members after such time(s) and date(s) (as applicable) shall be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend and vote at the meeting.
8. To be effective, this form of proxy, duly completed, must be lodged with Share Registrars Limited at 3 The Millennium Centre, Crosby Way, Farnham, Surrey GU9 7XX not less than 48 hours (ignoring any part of a day that is not a working day) before the time appointed for the meeting (being 10.00 a.m. on 24 June 2026) or any adjournment thereof together with, if appropriate, the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a certified copy of such power of attorney. If this form of proxy is not so lodged or submitted electronically (as described below), it may be handed to a representative of Share Registrars Limited or the Chair of the Court Meeting before the start of the Court Meeting.
9. In the case of a corporation, this form must be executed under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or agent who is duly authorised in writing to sign on behalf of the Corporation. In the case of an individual, this form must be signed by the individual or by an attorney duly authorised to sign on his/her behalf. In the case of joint shareholders, the signature of the senior shareholder (seniority to be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members) shall be accepted to the exclusion of all other joint holders. The names of all joint shareholders should be stated at the top of the form.
10. As an alternative to appointing a proxy, any member which is a corporation may appoint one or more corporate representatives who may exercise on its behalf all of its powers as a member, provided that they do not do so in relation to the same shares. Only one corporate representative is to be counted in determining whether under section 899(1) of the Companies Act 2006 a majority in number of the members approved the Scheme. The Chair of the Court Meeting may require a corporate representative to produce to Share Registrars, his or her written authority to attend and vote at the Court Meeting at any time before the start of the Court Meeting. The representative shall not be entitled to exercise the powers conferred on them by the member until any such demand has been satisfied.
